WHAT TO BRING: Boxes of unwanted documents that may contain personal information for secure destruction. Common types of unwanted items that should be shredded may include credit card statements or applications, bank statements, cancelled checks, old income tax information, insurance and medical records, and materials with identifying personal information like Social Security, credit card, or bank account numbers. ***Phonebooks, newspaper, and bound books cannot be accepted. Due to high demand and limited shredding capacity, please limit material to 5 boxes or bags per vehicle.***

To raise awareness of consumer fraud and to promote prevention of identity theft, we are hosting a shredding event to give individuals the opportunity to have unneeded confidential documents destroyed **FREE OF CHARGE**. Document shredding will occur on-site with the shredded paper later to be recycled. To accommodate the high volume of material to be shredded, additional secure collection trucks will be on site. All shredding will be performed by a local National Association for Information Destruction and Mobile Shredding Association member company.

This event is for individuals only, no businesses please. Limit of 5 boxes or bags per vehicle.
